Ms. Georgia Williams-Fitzpatrick was born and raised in Birmingham, Alabama. She received her undergraduate degree in Biology & Chemistry from the Tuskegee Institute in Tuskegee, Alabama. Before joining DoDDS in 1977, Ms. Fitzpatrick served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Liberia, West Africa, where she taught Science and Math. Upon returning to the States, Ms. Fitzpatrick taught Science in Atlanta, Georgia. Her first DoDDS assignment was in Bamberg, Germany, where she again taught Science for grades 7-10.

She returned to the States to earned her Masters degree followed by her Masters +30 in school Administration. Afterwards, she returned to DoDDS, this time teaching in Okinawa, Japan. She was promoted to Assistant Principal after teaching Science at Kubasaki High School for two years. Ms. Fitzpatrick served as Assistant Principal at Makiminato Junior High, Kinser Elementary School, and Kadena High School consecutively. In 1989 she became the Principal of Lakenheath Middle School in 1989 and became Principal of Sembach Elementary School and Sembach Middle School simultaneously for one year in 1997. In the following years, she has served as Principal of Sembach Intermediate School, Hanau Middle School, Wurzburg Middle School, and Neubruecke Elementary School.

Being that Ms. Fitzpatrick has served as an administrator in elementary, middle, and high schools levels, she has a good understanding of the stages of adolescence and enjoys the challenge that comes with teaching students at these critical stages in their young lives. Ms. Fitzpatrick especially enjoys interacting with elementary students because their learning is so quantifiable during these early grades.
